Required English Language certificate scores if studying in English at Hallym:
TOEFL 510 (CBT 197, iBT 71+) or IELTS (minimum overall score 5.5).

Korean Language certificate if studying in Korean at Hallym:
TOPIK Level 3+

All certificates must be within their expiration date at the time students apply for their Korean student VISA.

Required documents for application (incl. GPA)

TB certificate (for citizens of the countries listed below): (signed doctors letter confirming the student is free of TB (after chest X-Ray). This X-Ray should be typically taken just before the student visits the Korean Embassy in their home country for VISA approval.
