ABOUT HALLYM

Past, Present, and Future

Hallym University was founded with the dream of becoming a ‘small but great university.’ Now it is on its way to becoming a top-notch global university.



A Small But Great Beginning (1982-1988)

Hallym’s history can be traced back to the 1970s. Founder Dr. Duck-Sun Yoon had been a medical doctor, who had established the nation’s largest private hospital group, as well as an educator, who had dedicated himself to training medical professionals. In 1981, he acquired the Sungshim Women’s College in Chuncheon, Gangwon-do, and created the Ilsong Educational Foundation. Hallym University had its historical opening in March 1982, in Chuncheon, Gangwon-do, with four academic departments, including the Department of Medicine. Under the slogan ‘A Small But Great University’ and with the full support of the Foundation, Hallym attracted many distinguished scholars, up-and-coming professors, as well as talented students.

A New Beginning as a Comprehensive University (1989-2000)

Hallym University was promoted to a comprehensive university in 1989. In the mid-1990s, it responded to the changing times by emphasizing student individuality and practical education. It established the “Hallym 21st-Century Plan 1996-2005” to promote growth, conducted reforms to provide students with a wider range of options and experiences, and opened professional programs focusing on globalization and field work. In the late 1990s, Hallym University devoted its attention to educational reform and specialization projects, thereby making a successful transition to a school system in 2000. Thanks to such efforts, it achieved high rankings in annual university evaluations, conducted by reputable organizations, including the Ministry of Education.



Leading the 21st Century (2001-2015)

With the start of the 21st century, Hallym came to be recognized as a top-tier university in terms of faculty-student ratio, scholarship availability, classroom digitalization, financial stability, and research performance. Under the new motto ‘Mighty Hallym,’ it established the “Hallym 21st-Century Development Plan 2004-2010” in 2004 to look back on the past 20 years and set a new vision for the future. It reorganized the education system and expanded international exchange with the goal of producing creative and professional talents that meet the demands of a globalized world. Hallym’s efforts to boost competitiveness and specialize itself paid off. The Residential College program that it implemented in 2007 received recognition as a leading model of education. Hallym was also named a ‘well-teaching university’ that provides a differentiated learning environment and curriculum.



Education with 100 Years of Foresight (2016-Present)

Hallym has begun reinventing itself for the next 100 years. With the goal of providing ‘student-centered education’ and becoming a ‘top-notch global university’, it has implemented sweeping reforms. It has introduced a mandatory double major system as well as convergence majors. Under a school system, students have also been allowed to change affiliation more freely and choose from a wider range of disciplines to prepare themselves for the era of the Fourth Industrial Revolution. The quality of campus life has been enhanced through student census, the intramural sports league, and a car-free campus. In preparation for the Fourth Industrial Revolution and the post-COVID era, Hallym has also opened the Hallym Institute for Data Science and Artificial Intelligence(HIDA) and the School of AI Health and Life Care Sciences with the objective of producing multidisciplinary talents that will fill new chapters in Hallym’s 100-year history.

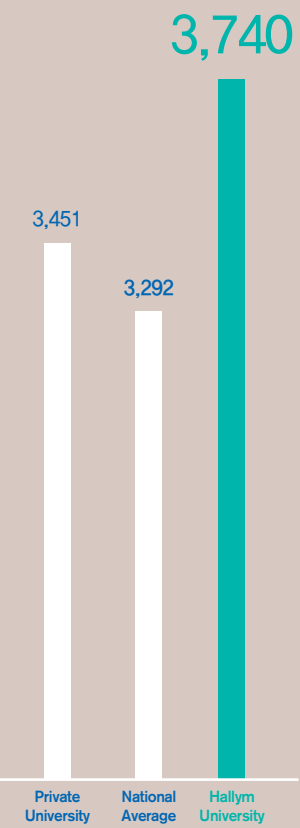


Globalization Programs

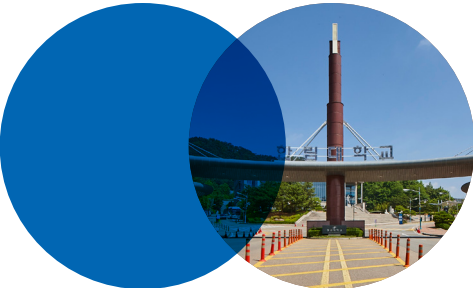

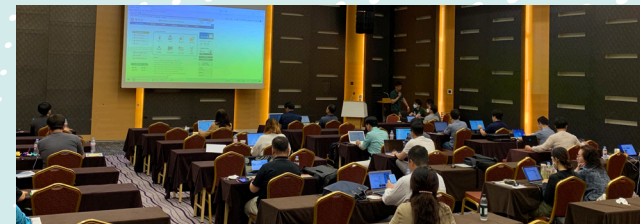

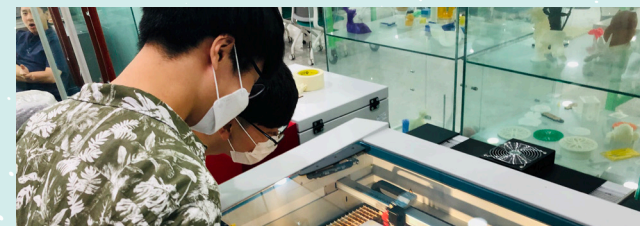

The fitness test room provides customized exercise prescriptions, using high-tech equipment to measure the physical ability and health status of students.

The Ilseong Memorial Library is a spacious building, representing a giant open window to the world. The exterior, made of stone and glass, is a blend of classic grandeur and futuristic design. The library has an administrative office and a museum on the 1st floor, its book collection on the 2nd, 3rd, and 5th floors, and a digital library and a creative studio on the 4th floor, serving as a space for students to 'enjoy and study' at the same time.

Museum



The museum opened as an institution affiliated to Hallym University in 1988 to collect and display artifacts and folk items from prehistoric and historic times, to provide students and local residents with a chance to understand history and culture through preservation and exhibition, and to contribute to the study of Korean history through cultural properties research. The museum has Exhibition Hall 1 (Archaeological History), Exhibition Hall 2 (Folk & Craft), and an outdoor exhibition area. It invites Hallym's faculty and students as well as local residents to take more interest in history through permanent exhibitions and academic lectures. It serves as a key institution that preserves and studies cultural properties within the province.

The Ilseong Art Hall opened in May 2000 as a performing arts center. Despite its short history, it has presented many top quality cultural events, quickly becoming one of the main performing arts centers in Chuncheon. It contributes to promoting arts and culture among Hallymers as well as local residents. It strives to make performing arts more accessible and enjoyable on Hallym campus at the foot of Bonggeui Mountain.
