

3. Eligibility Requirements

Foreign nationals whose parents are both foreign citizens and meet the following academic and language proficiency criteria

1. Academic Criteria

1) New: applicants who have graduated from high school (or are expected to graduate before August 2024) or have received approval of high school equivalency from an authorized organization

2) Transfer

- (1) Transfer as a Sophomore: applicants who have completed at least one year (two semesters) at a fouryear university in Korea or abroad, or who have graduated (or are expected to graduate before August 2024) from a two/three-year college
- (2) Transfer as a Junior: applicants who have completed at least two years (four semesters) at a four-year university in Korea or abroad, or who have graduated (or are expected to graduate before August 2024) from a two/three-year college

Applicant Eligibility Guidelines

- 1. Applicants who were admitted for the March intake of the same academic year cannot apply for the September intake.
- 2. If an applicant or either parent holds dual citizenship with Korea, he/she cannot apply as an international student.
- 3. If both the applicant and parents acquired foreign nationality before starting an educational program equivalent to Korean high school, he/she may apply as an international student with official documents proving the loss or renunciation of nationality.
- 4. In cases where submitting documents from both parents is difficult due to divorce, remarriage, death, or unmarried status, relevant documents of proof must be provided (divorce certificate, death certificate, etc.)
- 5. Applicants who have received GED, homeschooling, online/adult/lifelong education are not eligible to apply.

8. University Life

1. Global Mentoring

During the first semester, new students are matched 1:1 with a senior mentor who can provide support in academics and general life to help them overcome the challenges they may face and adapt to university life.

2. Career & Employment Support

Employment support programs for international students offer training in resume and personal statement writing, along with various special lectures for visa changes and job search. Through job fairs and company tours, students gain a better understanding of on-site practices and thereby enhance their employability and competitiveness.

3. Cultural Activities

Each semester, Hallym university organizes field trips to help international students explore Chuncheon and other areas of Gangwon province and get a first-hand experience of Korean culture.

4. Korean Language Education

Korean language courses are provided at multiple levels to improve international students' Korean language skills, and a curriculum for advanced Korean proficiency is on offer.

5. Dormitories

Hallym grants priority selection to international students applying for dormitories with a 100% dorm assignment rate.


