



3. Eligibility Requirements



Foreign nationals whose parents are both foreign citizens and meet the following academic and language proficiency criteria



1. Academic Criteria

1) New: applicants who have graduated from high school (or are expected to graduate before August 2025) or have received approval of high school equivalency from an authorized organization

2) Transfer

- ① Transfer as a Sophomore: applicants who have completed at least one year (two semesters) at a fouryear university in Korea or abroad, or who have graduated (or are expected to graduate before August 2025) from a two/three-year college
- ② Transfer as a Junior: applicants who have completed at least two years (four semesters) at a four-year university in Korea or abroad, or who have graduated (or are expected to graduate before August 2025) from a two/three-year college



Applicant Eligibility Guidelines

- 1. If an applicant or either parent holds dual citizenship with Korea, he/she cannot apply as an international student.
- 2. If both the applicant and parents acquired foreign nationality before starting an educational program equivalent to Korean high school, he/she may apply as an international student with official documents proving the loss or renunciation of
- 3. In cases where submitting documents from both parents is difficult due to divorce, remarriage, death, or unmarried status, relevant documents of proof must be provided (Divorce certificate, Death certificate, etc.)
- 4. Applicants who have received GED, Homeschooling, Online/adult/lifelong education are not eligible to apply.

2. Language Proficiency Criteria (Applicants must meet one or more of the following qualifications.)

1) Korean Language Track

- 1 Passer of Hallym University HU-TOPIK*
- 2 Holder of Level 2 or higher in TOPIK/TOPIK iBT

- ③ Graduate or current student of Intermediate 2 or higher level at the Hallym University Korean Language **Education Center**
- * Refer to 'Requirements for New Students based on Korean Language Proficiency' (page 7)

Transfer Holder of Level 3 or higher in TOPIK

- * HU-TOPIK(한림TOPIK): refer to the schedule on page 7
- 2) English Language Track: Holders of IELTS 5.5, TOEFL iBT 71, TOEFL Essentials 7.5, NEW TEPS 326 or above
- * Majors eligible for admission through English proficiency tests are Global Business and Korean Studies(transfer only).
- * Applicants from English-speaking countries or those who completed secondary/high school education in an English-speaking country can substitute English proficiency test scores with high school graduation certificates.

1) Admission Requirements for New Students who have not attained TOPIK Level 3

- ① Mandatory completion of at least 300 hours of intensive Korean language education during the 1st year (2 semesters)
 - Class hours: 160 hours per semester
- Cost: 1,000,000KRW per semester
- 2 Courses in major available from the 2nd year
 - Credits can be earned from required foundational and liberal arts courses during the 1st year.
- ③ Depending on attendance in intensive Korean language education, course enrollment or credit acquisition may be restricted in the following semester.

- 2. Name (in English) and date of birth must match the passport. For emergency contact, please provide accurate information such email, address, and phone number,
- 3. If the applicant is a graduating student and has submitted a certificate of expected graduation and the latest transcript, he/she must also provide the final certificate of graduation and transcript before Hallym University issues the admission certificate. Failure to submit these documents may result in an automatic cancellation of his/her admission.
- 4. **If a student currently enrolled in a 4-year university wishes to transfer**, he/she must submit original academic documents from both high school and university.
- 5. Applicants from Vietnam and Uzbekistan must submit a bank balance certificate issued by a Korean financial institution located in their respective countries.
- 6. The bank balance certificate may be requested again at the time of visa issuance, and additionally, proof of parents' employment and income may be required.
- 7. The bank balance certificate must have been issued within 30 days of the document submission date, and the deposit (freeze) period must be at least until the end of September 2025.
- 8. If both the applicant and parents renounced (or lost) Korean nationality before the applicant entered high school, documents proving this must be submitted. [Details and the date of loss of nationality must be clearly stated.]
- 9. All submitted documents will not be returned. Applicants are advised to prepare additional copies in advance for visa applications. As for such documents that cannot be reissued, original documents can be returned after verification. (Example: birth certificate, diploma, etc.)
- 10. Additional documents may be requested during the document review process, in which case the applicant must provide them at the earliest possible date.
- 11. If it is confirmed that an applicant has been admitted or enrolled through fraudulent means such as false information or document tampering, the admission or enrollment may be revoked.
- 12. If the submitted documents are incomplete or insufficient, visa issuance may be denied, and the responsibility lies with the applicant.
- 13. Individuals staying in the country must visit the Immigration Office(by making a reservation in advance) to apply for a change in residency status before the start of the semester. Individuals staying abroad should visit the Korean embassy(consulate) in your home country to apply in person.

1. Global Mentoring

During the first semester, new students are matched 1:1 or as a group with a senior mentor who can provide support in academics and general life to help them overcome the challenges they may face and adapt to university life.

2. Career & Employment Support

Employment support programs for international students offer training in resume and personal statement writing, along with various special lectures for Korean language learning, visa changes and job search. Through job fairs and company tours, students gain a better understanding of on-site practices and thereby enhance their employability and competitiveness.

3. Cultural Activities

Each semester, Hallym university organizes field trips to help international students explore Chuncheon and other areas of Gangwon province and get a first-hand experience of Korean culture.

4. Korean Language Education

Korean language courses are provided at multiple levels to improve international students' Korean language skills, and a curriculum for advanced Korean proficiency is on offer.

5. Dormitories

Hallym grants priority selection to international students applying for dormitories with a 100% dorm assignment rate.


