





- 3) All submitted documents will not be returned.
- 4) Any date and time on the timeline is based on those of Korea.
- 5) If necessary, a phone call or virtual interview may be requested.
- 6) Screening & Evaluation details are not subject to open to public.
- 7) Once the submission is done, you cannot cancel the application and the admission fee cannot be refunded.

Important Notices

- Applicant who are successfully admitted for the Spring semester cannot apply for the Fall semester within the same year.
- If anyone among the applicant and the parents has a dual nationality, the applicant cannot apply as an international student.
- If the applicant and the parents had already given up his/her Korean nationality before the applicant entered high school, the applicant can apply as an international student with an official proof document where the details and exact date of the loss of nationality is clearly stated.
- According to the parents' naturalization, if the applicant has a Korean nationality as of the application date, the applicant cannot apply as an international student.
- Applicants must submit both parents' document and it includes the proof of divorce, death, etc.
- Applicants who have received their education through GED, Online Education Programs or homeschooling, your application will be rejected due to not meeting the academic eligibility standards.

1) Detailed conditions

- The student must take Korean Language Course for 300 hours or more during the 1st year (2 semesters)
 - Current plan : 160 hours per semester
 - Extra Fee : individual charge
- The student can take major classes from the 2nd year
 - During the 1st year, the student must take compulsory basic classes and liberal arts classes corresponding to 15 credits per semester (30 credits per year)
- The student's attendance rate to Korean Language Course can affect regular course registration or credit earning
- If the student gets TOPIK level 3 score during the 1st year, the total hour of Korean Language Course changes to 120 hours
 - The deadline of submitting TOPIK level 3 score is 1 week before the class start date

2) Requirements for Graduation of International Students (both must be fulfilled)

- Compliance with the department graduation requirements
- Acquisition of TOPIK level 4 or above at latest 2 months before graduation (except for English track students)

How to get Apostille

A. Newly admitted students from countries that are a member of Apostille Treaty.

- Documents from Public schools
 - Step 1: Issue Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from public schools or institutions
 - Step 2: Visit an Apostille notary office for Apostille
- Documents from Private Schools
 - Step 1: Issue Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from private schools or institutions
 - Step 2: Visit a notary office for authentication
 - Step 3: Visit an Apostille office for Apostille

B. Admitted students from countries that are not a member of Apostille Treaty.

- Step 1: Issue Official certificates (transcripts, diplomas, etc.) from public, private schools or institutions
- Step 2: Visit an office of foreign ministry of the country where documents was issued for authentication
- Step 3: Visit an office of foreign ministry of Republic of Korea located in your country for authentication

05 Important Notes for Applicants

- Documents written in languages other than English or Korean must be accompanied with a complete Korean or English translation, authenticated by the issuing institution or notarized by a public notary.
- An applicant's transcript must be authenticated by Apostille or Consular Authentication.
 - Though an applicant from China graduated from must submit the official document issued by the government (Ministry of Education).
 - General high school : <http://www.cdgd.edu.cn>
 - Vocational high school : <http://mohrss.gov.cn>
 - Others : if there's no online issuance system, the document must be authenticated by the Korean Consular.
 - ※ For further information, please contact the Global Engagement Center.
- Insufficient documents can result in denial of visa issuance.
- All documents submitted will NOT be returned to the applicants under any circumstance. However, some documents that cannot be reissued can be returned after original control. (Hugubu, Diploma, etc.)
- Name and date of birth must be written exactly the same as in your passport. For 'emergency contact', please write down your E-mail address (Please do not use 'hotmail' accounts), phone number (including dialing codes) and postal address. We may need to contact you, using this information, so please ensure it is written correctly.
- If there are any false statements, or any other illegal acts, the application will be rejected, even after successful applicants have been announced.
- If academic records cannot be submitted by the application deadline, they must be submitted before the issuance of the Certificate of Admission can be authorized (for the processing of your VISA).
- If a graduate-to-be fails to acquire a diploma before the entrance date, the admission will be canceled.
- If the applicant is enrolled to a 4-year university, original academic documents from both high school and university must be submitted.
- Even after an applicant has submitted the required documents such as compulsory bank statement to Hallym at the time of application, the applicant may also be asked to produce another up-to-date one document, for instance, to the relevant VISA issuing authority for final approval of the VISA in their home country or the Korean immigrations. ※ Applicants from Vietnam and Uzbekistan must submit the bank statement issued by a Korean bank branch office in their country.
- Past dual citizenship holder who gives up Korean nationality must prove it with the official document, where the details and exact date of the loss of nationality is clearly stated.
- All newly admitted students must be insured by the Korean National Health Insurance (NHIS) following Korean Governmental rules for the duration of their study. Those who choose not to be insured may have problems with their VISA extension and face problems if medical treatment is required during their study. (In this situation the student will be responsible for rectifying any and all problems associated with this).

01 Dormitories & Supporting Departments

- 1) Dormitory application: Simultaneously when applying for admission
- 2) Location: On Campus
